Onsite Supervision

Hastings Primary School will continue to provide onsite supervision for students who's parents need to work.

Please note the directive is still the same as last term. If students can learn from home they must learn from home.

Onsite supervision is reviewed weekly so parent/carers are required to fill out a form weekly.

Forms need to be submitted by 2pm Thursday the week before attendance is required.

Masks

As per the government directive, mask are mandatory at 11:59pm Wednesday 23rd July. Students are not required to wear masks whilst attending onsite attendance however will not be discouraged if they want to wear them.

Although we were hoping for the return of face The staff will be following the government within the school grounds.

VICTORIA'S FACE MASK RULES

Face masks must be worn outside the home in metropolitan Melbourne and Mitchell Shire, including most workplaces

The "common sense" rules allow exemptions for medical issues and when a mask is "entirely impractical'



Sometimes I might see people wearing face masks at the store.

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
Wearing a mask at a store is a new thing. This is because of a germ called COVID-19.


Before COVID-19, I usually only saw doctors and nurses wearing a face mask.

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


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
The people wearing masks can still talk and they might even be smiling at me. I just can't see their mouth.

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Some people wear glasses, some people wear hats, and some people wear masks.


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Seeing people wearing masks is different. But, it's okay!
