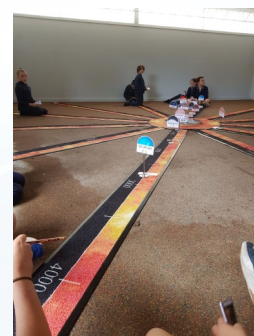
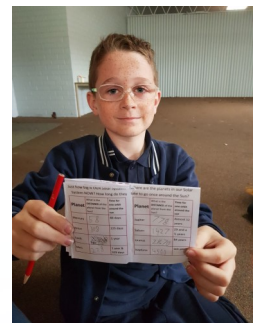
Onsite Attendance Form
