Hastings Primary School - Peace Pole

Last week, Hastings Primary School came together for a very special occasion – the installation of our Peace Pole. We would like to acknowledge and thank the Hastings & Westernport Rotary Club for sponsoring this project and for their ongoing support of our school.

The Peace Pole is an international symbol of hope and unity, first established in Japan after the tragedies of Hiroshima and Nagasaki. Since then, more than 250,000 Peace Poles have been placed around the world, each carrying the powerful message, "May Peace Prevail on Earth."

Our school's Peace Pole is part of a national initiative that began during the Centenary of Rotary in Australia. In 2021, the Rotary Club of Canberra Burley Griffin set a goal to see 100 Peace Poles donated to 100 schools to mark 100 years of Rotary service in Australia.

The Peace Pole program itself began in 1955, created by Masahisa Goi, founder of the World Peace Prayer Society.

Today, Peace Poles can be found in nearly 200 countries, each one a silent reminder of the common wish for a world at peace.

At Hastings Primary School, our Peace Pole stands as a symbol of our commitment to peace, respect, and building a positive future together. Our students worked together to choose the wording for two of the sides, and our School Council selected our school mission statement for another.

During the ceremony, our students proudly read out each side of the Peace Pole:

- Side One: May Peace Prevail on Earth
- Side Two: Hastings Primary School Building the Future
- Side Three: Kindness unites our unique world
- Side Four: Celebrate and respect every culture

This special addition to our school grounds will remain a lasting reminder of our values and will connect us to a worldwide community of peace.

Responding to Anxiety in Children: What you can do as a parent

While many children can manage anxiety with family support, certain warning signs indicate the need for professional intervention:

- · Create predictable routines and environments that foster a sense of security, whilst gradually exposing your child to manageable challenges that build confidence. Remember, building resilience is like strengthening a muscle-it requires consistent, progressive effort.
- Early recognition and intervention are our best tools for helping children develop the resilience they'll need to navigate an increasingly complex world.



\$100 POWER SAVING BONUS

FOR ELIGIBLE CONCESSION CARD HOLDERS

The new \$100 Power Saving Bonus for Victorian concession card holders is now open. Households with an eligible concession card can apply for a \$100 payment by visiting the Victorian Energy Compare website (compare.energy.vic.gov.au).

To apply for the \$100 payment, applicants will need to hold an eligible concession card, have a recent electricity bill and be the account holder. Only one payment is available per household.
